

How to Guide for Newspaper Archive

Once you click the link for the Newspaper Archive, you use the following steps to access the database

1. On the Seneca Library District login page
 - a. enter your username (your library card number)
 - b. enter your PIN (typically this is the last four digits of the phone number listed in your library account)
2. Once you are in the Newspaper Archive, create a free account to
 - a. Save and organize unlimited **Image Clippings** in your Favorites folder
 - b. Create **Saved Searches** to notify you when relevant content has been added
 - c. Create a **Personal Archive** of your favorite pages
3. You can **Search** the database of newspapers by
 - a. Person's name
 - b. Keyword
 - c. Publication's Title
4. You can **Browse** the database of newspapers by
 - a. Location
 - b. Date
 - c. Publication
