GET STARTED:

Once you click the *Gale Presents: Udemy* link you will be taken to the Seneca Library District login page.

- Enter your username (your library card number)
- Enter your PIN (typically this is the last four digits of the phone number listed in your library account)

When you arrive on the Udemy page, use the **Sign In/Create Udem Account** button to log into *Gale Presents: Udem*.

(You will use this button every time you use Udem to access your courses and keep track of your learning.)

FIND COURSES:

Browse *Gale Presents: Udem*'s home page for suggested courses, or jump back into your current courses.

Search for courses of interest or click **Categories** to browse for courses by subject area.

To learn more about a course, simply click its title.
